Como o inglês fala sobre o futuro

O inglês não tem um único tempo verbal de futuro — a escolha entre will, going to, o presente contínuo e o presente simples depende de planos, previsões e evidências.

will: decisões tomadas na hora, ofertas, promessas e opiniões sobre o futuro: I'll help you.

going to: intenções decididas antes e previsões com evidência no presente: We're going to move. / It's going to rain.

Presente contínuo: compromissos marcados com pessoas ou horários: I'm meeting Tom at six.

Presente simples: horários e grades fixas: The train leaves at 9:40.

Palavras-chave: tomorrow, next week, soon, in 2030, tonight
